NOTES FROM THE NURSE

Welcome to ECC! I am looking forward to sharing this exciting school year with you and your child. Here are a few need to knows & what to do's!

**** FEVER** is considered a **temperature of 100** or greater. It is our district policy that a student be sent home for a recorded temp of 100 or greater and to <u>remain home</u> until free of fever for at least 24 hours **without** any fever-reducing medications. Please **DO NOT** send your child back to school until this time frame has been met **AND** your student is feeling well enough to participate in all activities for the school day.

** VISION & HEARING SCREENINGS: All Pre-K and Kindergarten students are required by state law to be screened. I will begin with our Kindergarten students in September (sometimes sooner). Please have your child wear their glasses if prescribed and notify me of any concerns.

** **VACCINES:** If your child will be due any vaccines this school year I will send home reminders. Return proof of the <u>state required</u> vaccines by the due date in order for your child to remain in the classroom this school year.

** **ABSENCES:** You must call our office before 10:00 am to report any absences, even if you have let the teacher know. **Call 903-881-4400.**

** **HEADLICE** s a common childhood nuisance! IF your child has an active case of head lice (live bugs) they WILL be sent home to be treated ASAP & a specific classroom notification letter will be emailed to that class' parents. Your child will need to be rechecked by the nurse PRIOR to returning to the classroom. PLEASE discuss with & discourage your child from sharing any combs/brushes, hats, hair bows/clips, jackets, etc.

** **EXTRA CLOTHING:** I have limited extra clothing to use for those unplanned potty accidents—please wash them & return. I highly encourage you to provide an extra set of clothing to keep in your child's backpack or cubby. *There may be circumstances in which I will have you pick up your child to clean at home or come to campus to assist them with cleaning.* Please "practice" bathroom training/hygiene with your child.

** HANDWASHING with soap & water is the #1 way to prevent the spread of infection!

** **MEDICATIONS:** All medications must be taken to the nurse office and must have a form completed & signed by both the guardian AND doctor.
